

1. The allergy testing is done at our **Robbinsdale** and **Maple Grove** offices and will take 1 to 1-1/2 hours.
2. **PLEASE** eat breakfast and/or lunch. **NO** gum, eating or drinking during testing. (except for plain water)
3. **PLEASE** wear a **sleeveless** shirt. Allergy skin testing is done on the upper arms and forearms.
4. Do **NOT** use hairspray, perfume, cologne, after-shave, body lotion, or other scented products when you come to our office. Deodorant is fine as long as it is not heavily scented.
5. **Certain medications will invalidate the testing results; therefore:**
 - **NO** forms of Allegra, Zyrtec, Xyzal, Clarinex, Claritin, Atarax, or Vistaril including generic forms (i.e. loratadine, Alavert, fexofenadine, cetirizine or hydroxyzine) for **10 days before testing**.
 - For **3 days before testing**, you **MUST STOP** all other antihistamines, decongestants, nasal sprays, Tagamet, Zantac, Axid, Pepcid or other over the counter acid reflux medications, pain medications with codeine, cough drops, cough syrups and over the counter sleeping aids.
 - **NO** Singulair, Prilosec, Prevacid, Reglan, Propulsid or other prescription acid reflux medicationS the night before and morning of testing.
 - **NO** topical steroids on arms the day of testing.
 - **NO** Antivert or Dramamine or the generic meclizine for 4 days before testing.
 - **NO** herbal supplements, including herbal teas, for 7 days before testing.
 - **NO** skin testing if on a beta blocker; must have ordering physician's okay to be off for 3 days.

If you are not sure if testing is covered, **please check** with your insurance company. Patients are required to pay for testing on that day if they have Company/Private insurance, and are not on an HMO.
